

## CHECKLIST -Am I ready to open my EcoShop?

☐ Register with your local authority
Make sure to call your local Environmental Health department and check if you need to register. If they advise you do, this is a legal requirement, and it is recommended you register at least 28 days before you plan to open.
☐ Staff and Volunteers
You will need staff members or volunteers to take delivery of stock, set up and take down (if you are a pop up), man the EcoShop, clean food storage areas and display equipment, handle cash etc.
☐ Setting up essentials
The set-up essentials for an EcoShop vary massively between EcoShops, but you will need as a minimum, 1. A venue 2. Tables/ displays 3. Cash tin 4. PPE 5. Safe storage for spare food.
☐ Food hygiene / Food Safety training
All staff members and volunteers within your EcoShop must receive relevant training to their position. This ensures that your EcoShop is operating safely, legally, and effectively.
☐ Safer Food Better Business
Make sure to check with your local authority if you need a Safer Food Better Business system in place. Some
EcoShops only provide an outlet for low-risk ambient foods and therefore do not need a SFBB in place.
Instead, they need a procedure of good practices to protect stock. Other EcoShops do need to develop a SFBB system. Check with your local authority and contact us if you need support with your SFBB.
